Green & Gold Booster Club General Meeting Minutes August 11, 2025 via Zoom

Call to order: 7:02 pm

Roll Call: Unified Sports, Volleyball, Softball, Girls Soccer, Boys Tennis, Girls Swim, Cheer, Grad Night, Boys Soccer, Boys Wrestling were all represented. Note: Please be sure your team is represented at every meeting.

Upcoming Events:

-Golf Tournament: Saturday August 16th. 60 golfers registered. Starts at 10am, last tee time is 12:04 pm. We need more volunteers Friday night and Saturday. Amy volunteered to help set up hole sponsor signs Friday night. Update: Golf Tournament went very well! 60 players, 15 teams, raised roughly \$8,000 (exact number to be announced)

-Back to School Days: Boosters is hoping to have a table **Update: boosters will be at all 3 back to school days.**

Meetings:

- -2nd Monday of each month. We will have 1 in person on 9/8 in Building C Commons, and then 2 online, then in person again and so on.
- -Anyone can attend but you must be a member to vote. We vote on the previous meeting's minutes at every meeting and occasionally there are other things that need to be voted on. Membership is free but everyone needs to go to the website and fill out a membership form, even if you've done it before all forms have been cleared for the new school year.

Website:

- -Molly shared her screen and showed the membership join form.
- -Shared the schedule and explained that it gets updated from what we can see on the Wesco site. Coaches/parents please let us know if there is a change to your game/match so we can update it. We understand you may not think to tell us, but please remember that may mean it doesn't get updated.
- -Team Pages: each team can have a site accessed from the main GGBC site with schedules, link to their Adrenaline store etc. This would make it easy for parents to find all the info they need for a specific sport.
- -Store: GGBC has a store with generic GGBC gear. This helps raise money for the General Fund to cover our operating costs and expenses (e.g. insurance, storage unit, supplies etc). We have blankets, bracelets, pom poms, Spirit Wear and gift cards.

Coach Acknowledgement Forms:

-Coach Acknowledgement Forms need to be signed each school year. They will be emailed later this week. A line has been added to specify team and Coach (head or assistant).

Fundraising:

- *Remember you can not set up booths or advertise you're hosting a fundraiser outside of the restaurants so make sure you advertise beforehand.
- -Team Fundraisers: Restaurants (Panda Express, MOD, Red Robin, Qdoba, Panera), the auction, tournaments, camps, Adrenaline Online Store, ticket sale volunteers are all fundraisers to earn money for individual teams/band.
- -General Fund Fundraisers: Spirit Store, Pampered Chef, Bricks, Sponsor Board are all things that raise money for the GGBC General Fund.
- "-Full Boosters" Fundraisers: Charleston Wrap, Mariners Tickets, SilverTips Tickets put together by GGBC but teams get credit for what they sell.
- -Online Sales: Little Caesars, Sockables, Double Good Popcorn, Fun Pasta, Give Butter, Sees Candy, Floral, Poppin Popcorn, Thats My Pan
- -Adrenaline Team Stores: Currently signed up Boys Tennis, Girls Basketball, Golf, Unified Sports, Basketball, Band, Class of 2026, Girls Tennis, Cheer, Football & Baseball
- -Other: Alfy's (cards), Chick-Fil-A (cards/coupons), Senior Signs, Adrenaline, Kettle Corn. These MUST have a parent meeting with a GGBC Board Member BEFOREHAND. There are a lot of rules Booster Clubs have to follow. Anything that asks people to give money for an item; coaches and students can NOT handle money, those must be parent only involvement.
- -Restaurant Partners: Applebee's Pancake Breakfast, 5 Rights, Village Inn, DQ, Hops & Drops, Spaghetti Factory, Coconut Kennys, Menchies are all options but they're harder to set up than the other restaurant fundraisers.
- -Auction: Last year approximately \$50,000 went to teams. Teams put together baskets (silent and/or live auction items). Teams get 90% of the sale price of their donated items, GGBC gets 10% (to cover credit card fees and basket supplies like baskets and

cellophane wrap, tape etc). The auction will be April 17, 2026 at Tulalip Resort & Casino. More info will be coming soon but start thinking about and collecting auction items.

- -Tournaments/Camps: This is a good way to earn money. Volleyball had 99 kids registered for their camp this summer and made about \$5,000. Cheer camps start at age 5 and go through 9th grade. Camps can be done any time of the year, not just in the summer. Cheer hosts a fall camp and then they perform during a football game. MG athletes volunteer and help run the camps.
- -Ticket Sales & Concessions: Parents/adults can sign up to sell tickets at sporting events. MSD pays Boosters for your time and you can designate a team/band for your money earned to go to. Keep an eye out for a sign-up genius coming soon.
- -URL for fundraiser requests will be posted on the website.
- -Molly reviewed the differences between ASB & Boosters (see attached) and the info will be posted. The biggest thing is coaches and students can NOT handle money or it automatically becomes ASB.

Cash Boxes & Card Readers:

Every team should have a card reader. Let us know if you don't have one (if you're going to need one). Email Kalee (<u>Treasurer@greenandgoldboosters.org</u>) if you need a cash box/reader. Please give at least one week's notice so we can go to the bank etc. If you're selling product(s) and need things added to the "store", please give Molly 72 hours notice so it can be added from our end (<u>info@greenandgoldboosters.org</u>).

General reminders:

- -Minimum of 72 hours notice is requested for ANY and ALL requests.
- -We have 26 teams we are supporting this year that means a LOT of requests are coming in. Please be mindful that you are not the only person asking for something.
- -Meetings are on the 2nd Monday of each month at 7pm (note the new time)
- -We are all volunteers. We are all human. Be kind. Be respectful.
- -We are not paid by the school/district.
- -We are a non-profit organization (that means all donations are tax deductible)

Sponsorship Board:

-The signs for the sponsorship board in the gym are handmade by us, so if there is someone who would like to help/do this for us in the future that would be great.

C-teams:

-The district is not paying for C-teams this year, they have asked Boosters to cover the costs. The costs have increased a lot. They have asked us to raise \$40,000 but the actual cost is over \$60,000. We have currently raised approximately \$7500 (Golf Tourney, Auction and Give Butter donations). Meaghan said the number of interested volleyball players reflects the need for a C-team; she asked if there is a cut-off date for when we need to have the money raised by. The answer was "we don't know" and we recommend she ask the district for a deadline. We also suggested coaches/parents ask MSD how much C-teams will cost and for a breakdown.
