Still need sponsorships, teams to sign up, auction, and volunteers. Please help support by signing up or sharing information. Donations can be made directly through the link on the GGBC site. 14 teams signed up and would like to have a goal of 20 teams. Scott Swanson has donated drinks and beverages. The city is giving us the site at a discounted rate of \$3000. Need volunteers' the day of to sell tickets, take money, distribute meal tickets, facilitate auction, help as needed. It is estimated that for football, volleyball, basketball, and wrestling C-teams that we will need to raise approximately \$24,000. Teams who have C-teams should check in with Kaylee to see what their account balance is currently as they might already have some of the monies needed to fund their C-team programs. The money will be used to pay officials and pay for buses. Coaches for C-teams are volunteers. Football and volleyball funds \$14,000 before school starts. Basketball and wrestling monies can be paid later.

9/28 Saturday - Spirit Night at the Seattle – Update – due to scheduling conflict (game is the same night as Homecoming) this fundraising event will be canceled. We will look into scheduling a spring game fundraiser event.

10/10-21- Charleston Wrap Fundraiser – catalogue sales, 40% goes to your team, this is an online fundraiser.

4/25/25- Auction Gala- to be held at the Tulalip Casino. All teams are encouraged to start collecting auction baskets and items now.

5. **Spirit Wear update:**

- **Clearance sale** of old items on website (tee shirts, hoodies, etc. at very discounted cost), items can be picked up from Molly, next meeting day, or at the back to school days. Pom-poms are now available.

- **New items** available for online order and shipping new items will be posted soon on the Facebook page and GGBC website. New items will be available to order online and will be shipped right to you. Lots of cool new items which can be personalized.

6. **Fundraiser How To's-** All fundraisers must be done through the GGBC. This will help us to keep things organized, ensure that our club tax id # is used correctly. Restaurant fundraisers are done once per month. Come to a GGBC meeting to sign up for fundraisers. Many regular team fundraisers are already approved. Contact GGBC for approval for fundraisers. This applies to grants as well. Some programs will only allow 1 fundraiser (per tax id #) per month or year, all our teams use the GGBC tax id. We do not want to lose the opportunity to fundraise with programs, we want to be able to adhere to their guidelines for fundraising.

7. **Football Games discussion-** spirit wear will not be sold at games. An idea is to sell specific themed items at each game night that coincides with each of the game night themes. Items will be low cost (such as \$1 for glow sticks, etc.).

8. **Account Balances update:** If you have a question about your team balance, please contact Kalee Sentinella. Reimbursement requests must be approved by coaches for requests over \$100. Coaches please be aware and know that you may be getting notifications about this so that we can ensure that parent purchases for teams are approved by coaches. With a total of 24 groups please be patient with requests as it takes time to process payments in/out to ensure that monies are allocated to the appropriate team.

Online and credit card orders total from last year- please check with Kalee to check in on your team's current balance.

9. **Acknowledgement of volunteer efforts and limitations-** All board members are working hard to support our programs and teams but are all volunteers (not paid) who are all working full time outside of the group.
